ENROLLMENT PROCESS OF NCC CADETS

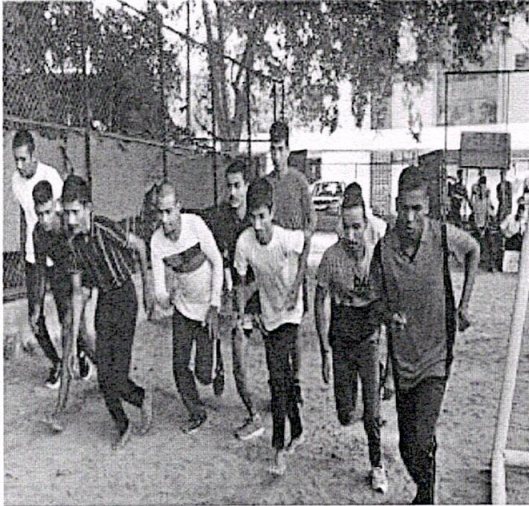
First-year students have been notified that the selection process for NCC Senior Division (SD/Boys) & Senior Wing (SW/Girls) will be conducted in accordance with NCC Rules and Regulations.

1. **Eligibility Conditions:**As per NCC ACT (Act XXXI of 1948)
2. **Enrolment/Motivation Lecture:**Enrolment/Motivation Lecture shall be carried out by Commanding Officer/AO and PI Staff of 1 Gujarat Battalion NCC, Ahmedabad.
3. **Physical examination:** This is first step of selection procedure. It includes run, chin-up/push-ups, sit-up etc. Cadets are given Tentative Time, Date & Location for Physical examination, Written Test and Interview.
4. **Written test and Interview:**Written test will be conducted after physical examination. It will have questions on Current Affairs and General Knowledge followed by Interview.
5. **Application for Enrolment:**Selected and Reserve cadets after above mentioned examination are given application forms on the same date. (NCC A Cert holders will be given additional 10 marks, Students having National/ State level participation Certificate will be accorded 10/5 marks, Participants to be in possession of 12th class mark sheet for final merit.
6. **Medical Examination:**Cadets filling the forms have to undergo medical examination.
7. **Documents required:**10th and 12th class mark sheet, Blood group certificate, Aadhar Card photocopy, Cadet's Bank account details photocopy, College admission fee receipt, 04 Passport size photo civil uniform, etc.
8. **Fees:**It is mandatory for anyone joining NCC as a cadet to become a member of Cadets Welfare Society by paying Rs. 15/- (one time) at the time of enrolment and Rs.4/- for regiment cutting.
9. **Submission of Filled Application Forms with Fees:**Nominal roll (Cadet Data Capture) prepared and signed by Associate NCC Officer. After Principal's signature it

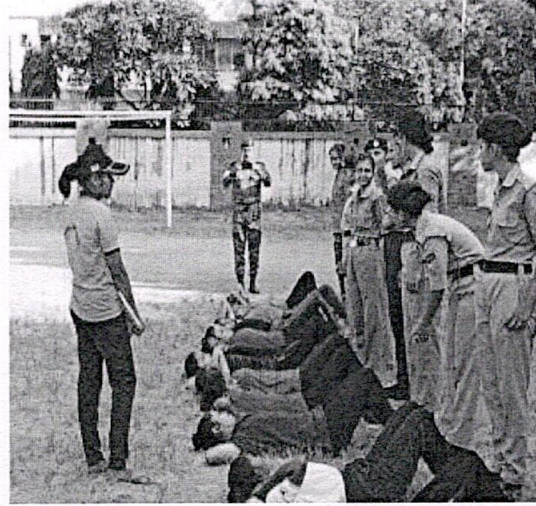
is submitted to 1 Gujarat Battalion with required fees which will complete entire enrolment process. This process may take 15-20 days depending on cadets enrolled.

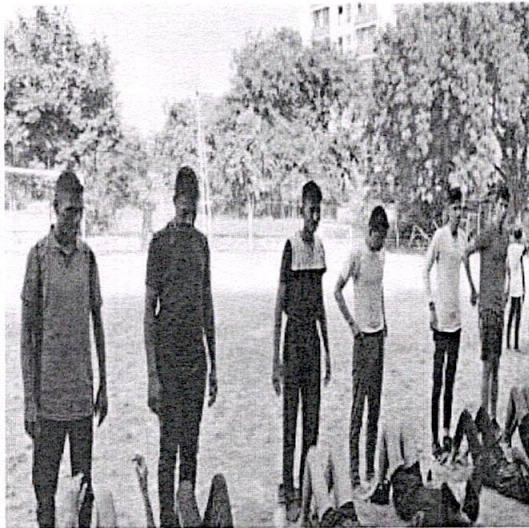

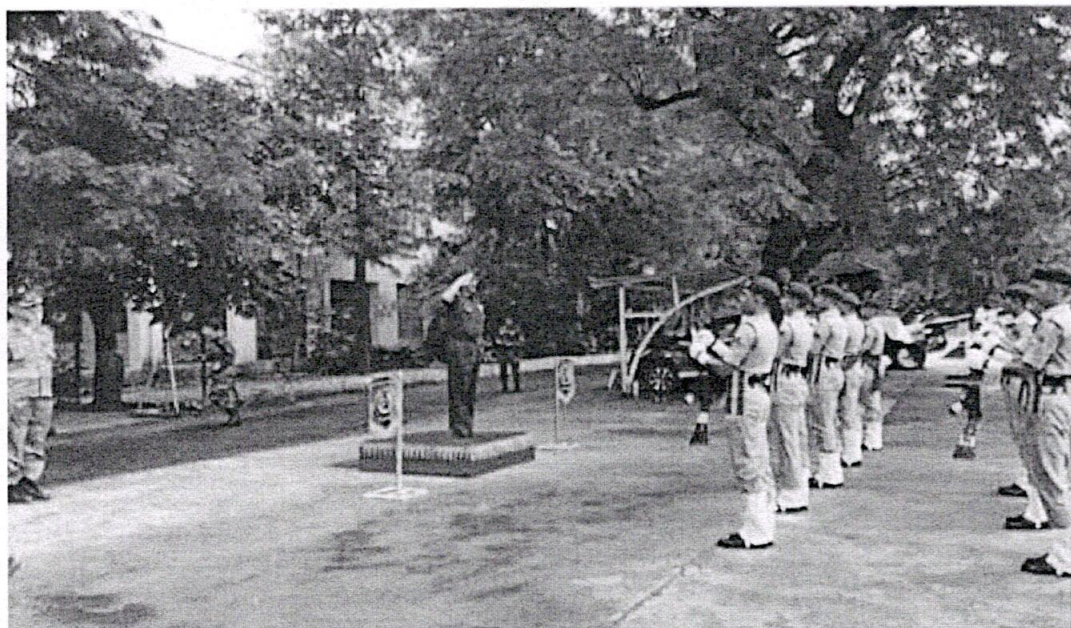

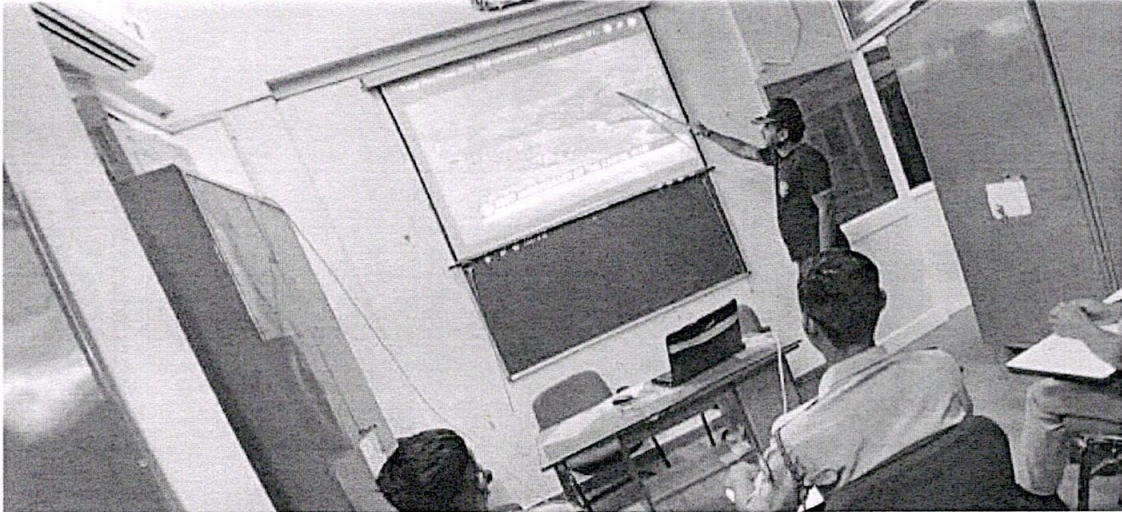
2. KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS:

The lecture delivered by Associate NCC Officer Capt. 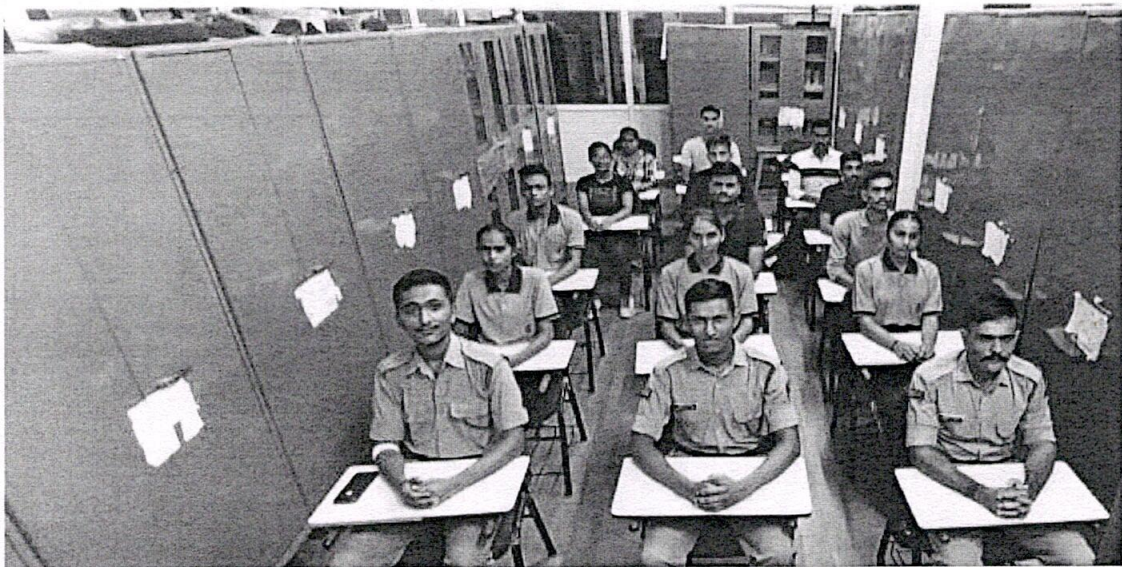

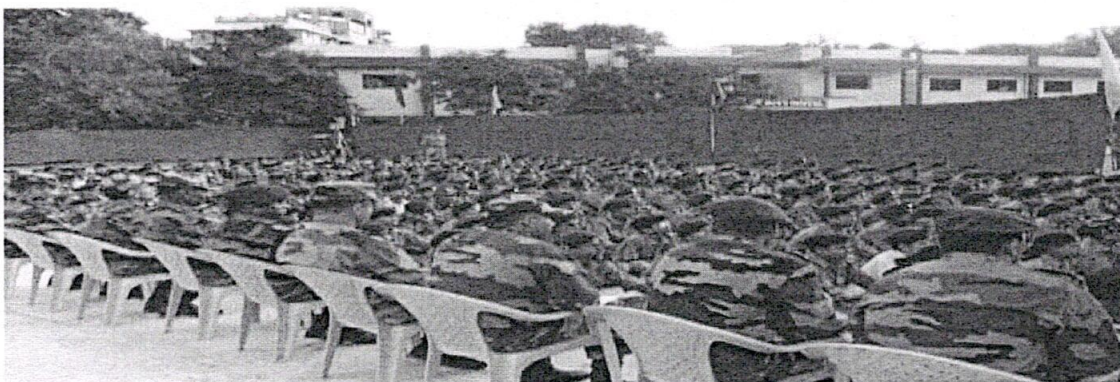

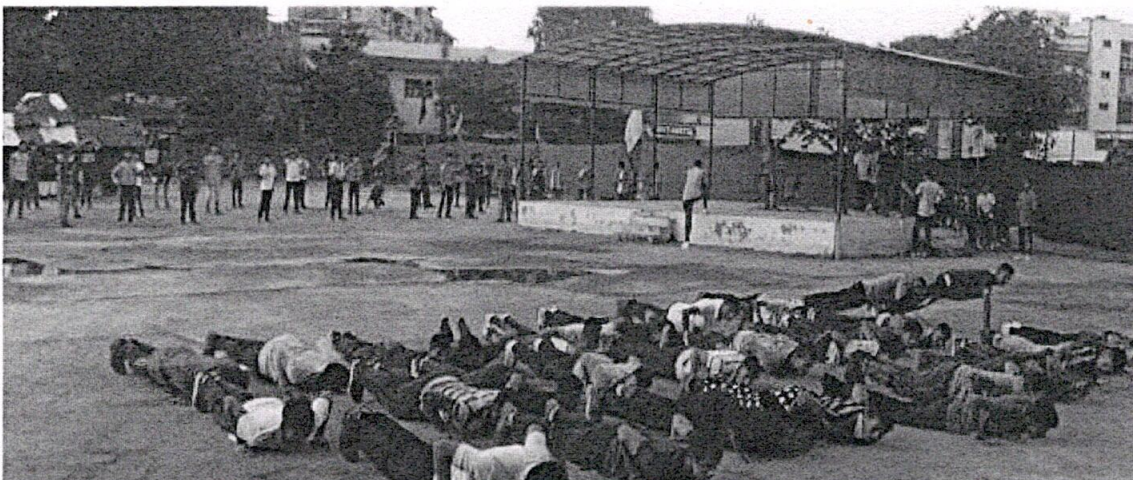

1. COMBINED ANNUAL TRAINING CAMP (CATC) –VI

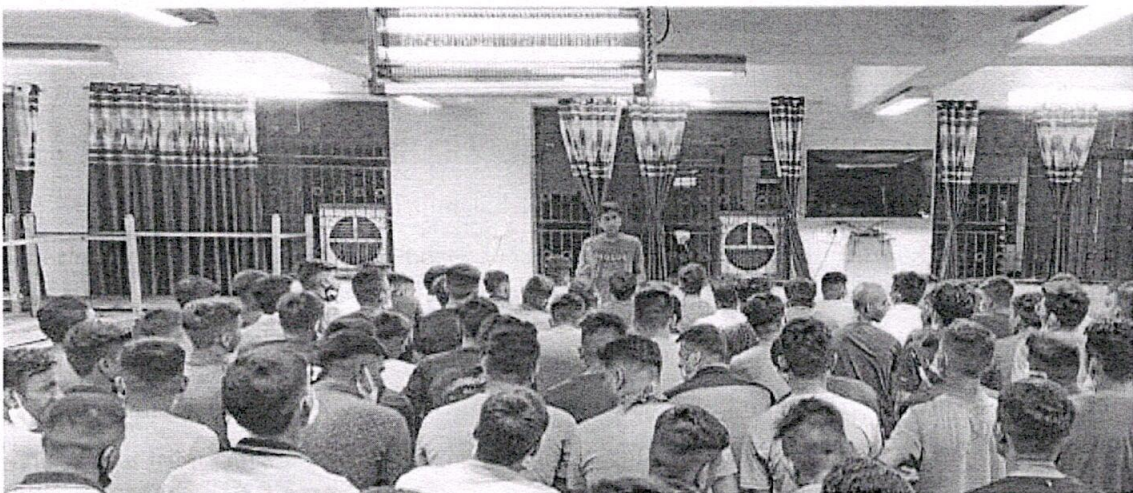

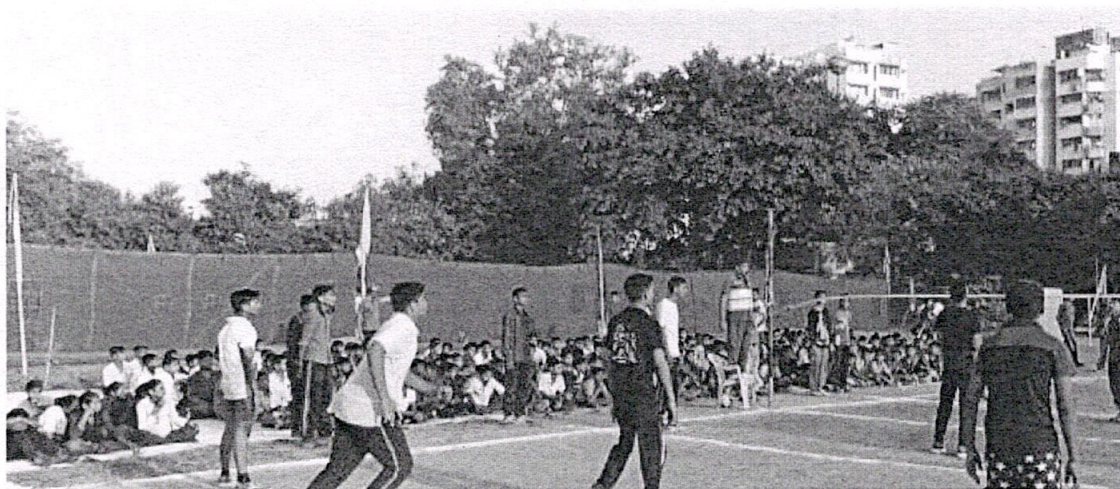
2. EK BHARAT SHRESTHA BHARAT (EBSB) – INDEPENDENCE DAY CAMP:

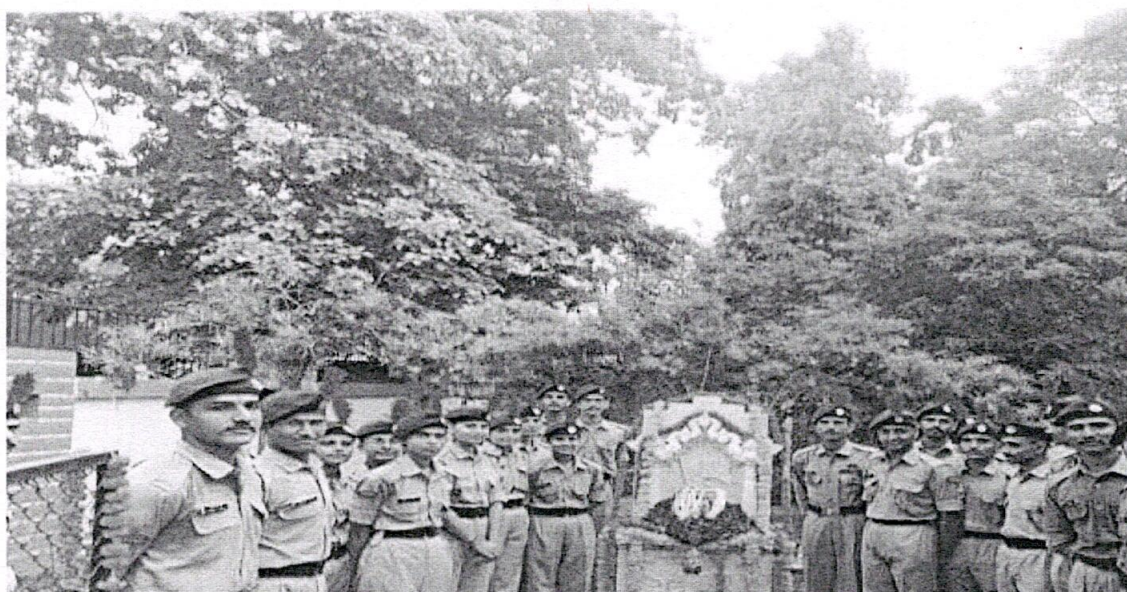

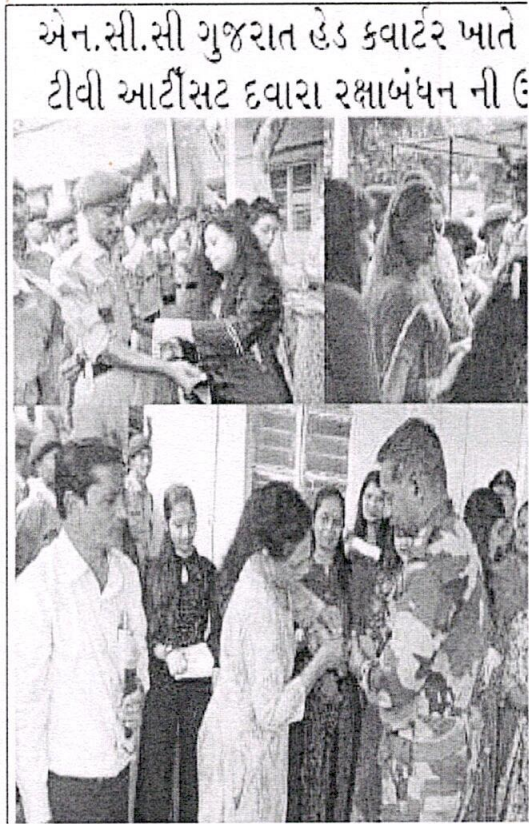

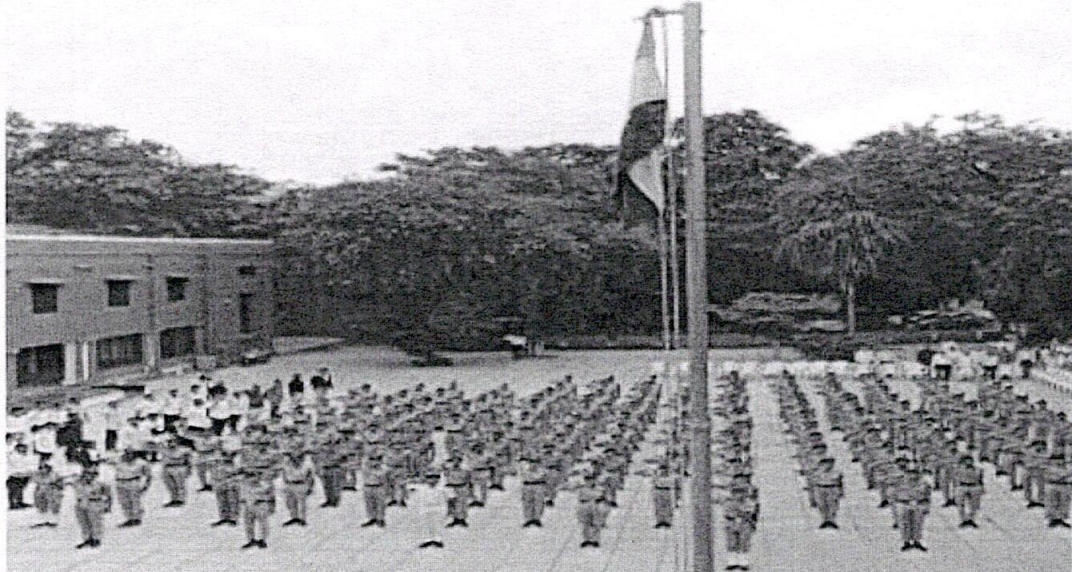

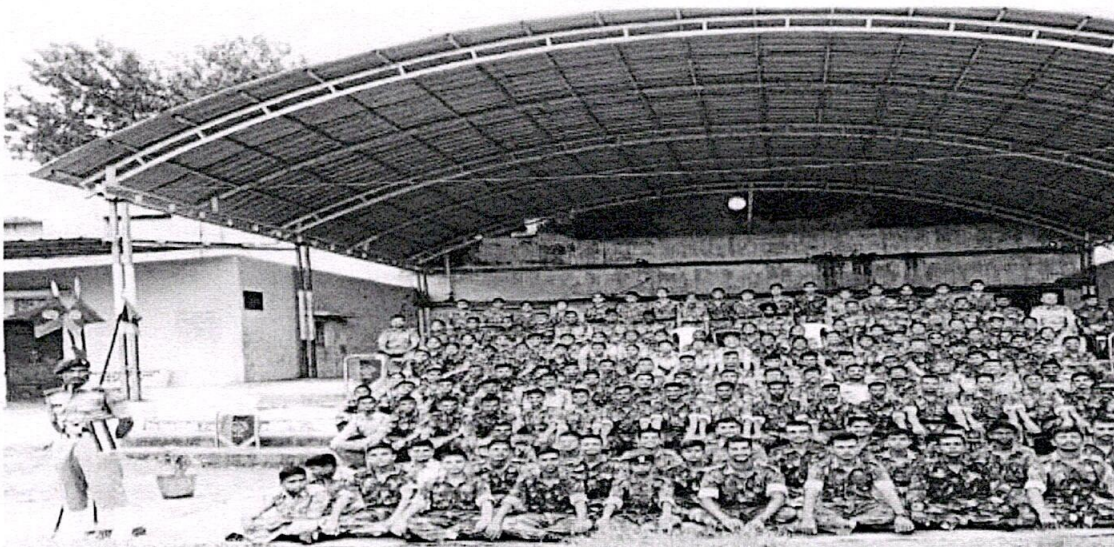
8. PRE ThalSenaCamp 2 (PRE-TSC2):

The **TSC (ThalSena Camp)** is a prestigious 12-day event conducted annually in Delhi during the late autumn season, serving as a platform for cadet excellence. Selection of cadets from all 17 directorates, with quotas of 30+3 cadets per directorate, occurs through a rigorous process involving three pre-TSC camps, each spanning 10–12 days with a week's interval between them.

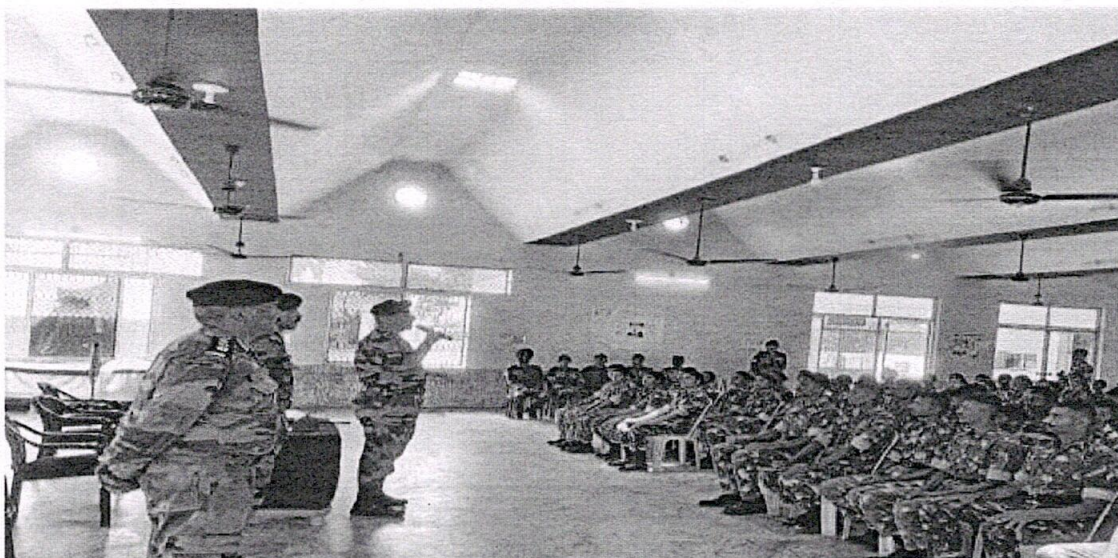
Chosen cadets represent their respective directorates in diverse competitions such as obstacle courses, firing exercises (including grouping, snap-shooting, and application), map reading challenges, and home nursing tasks, showcasing their skills and teamwork abilities.

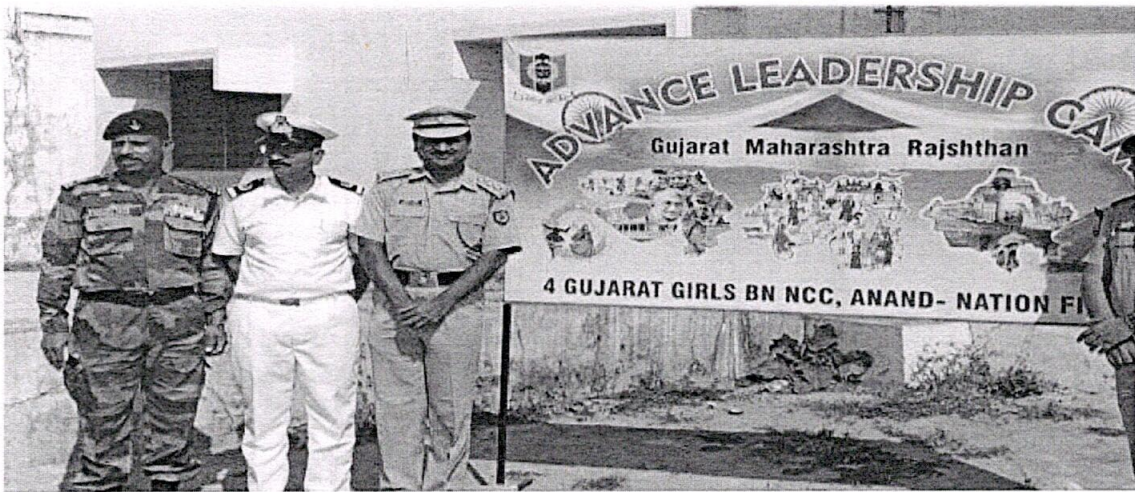

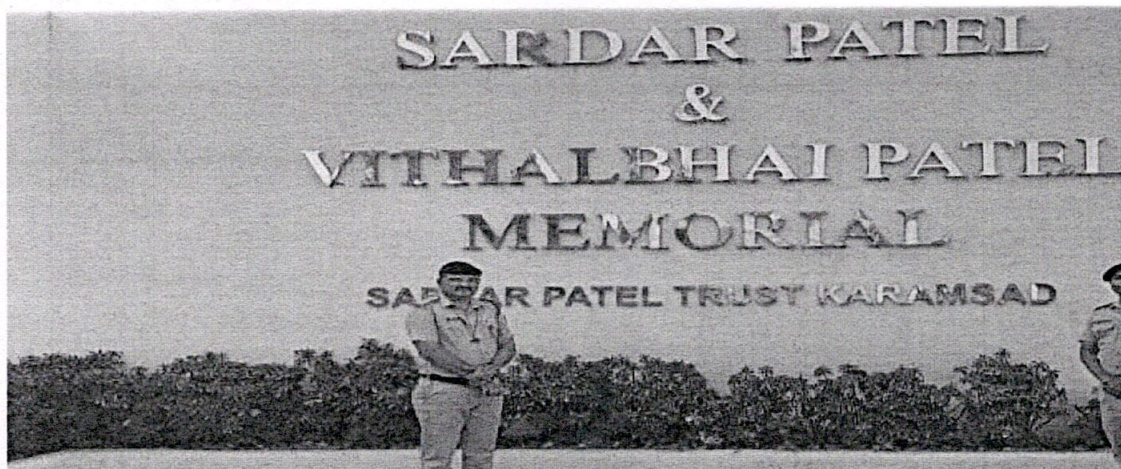

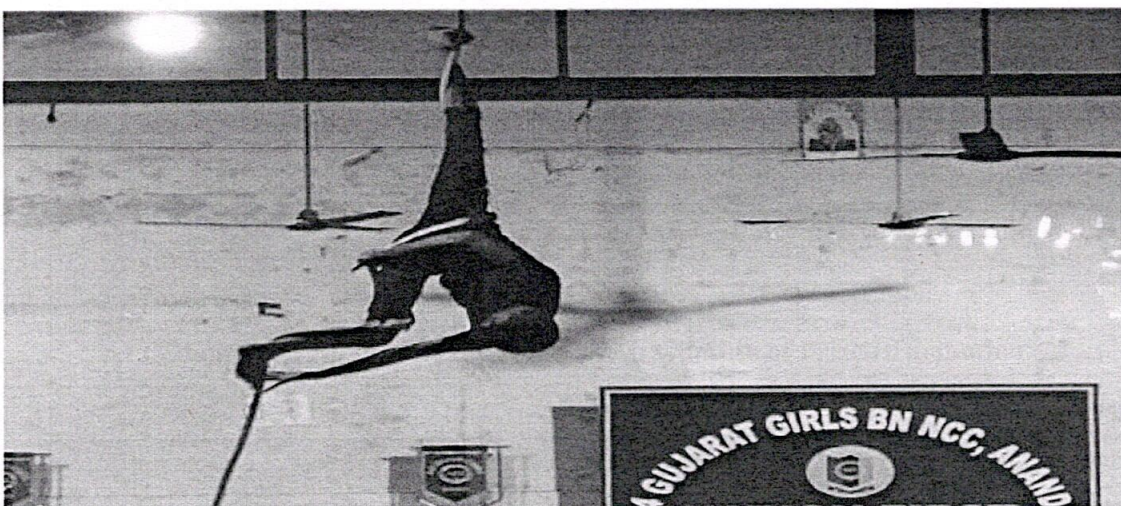

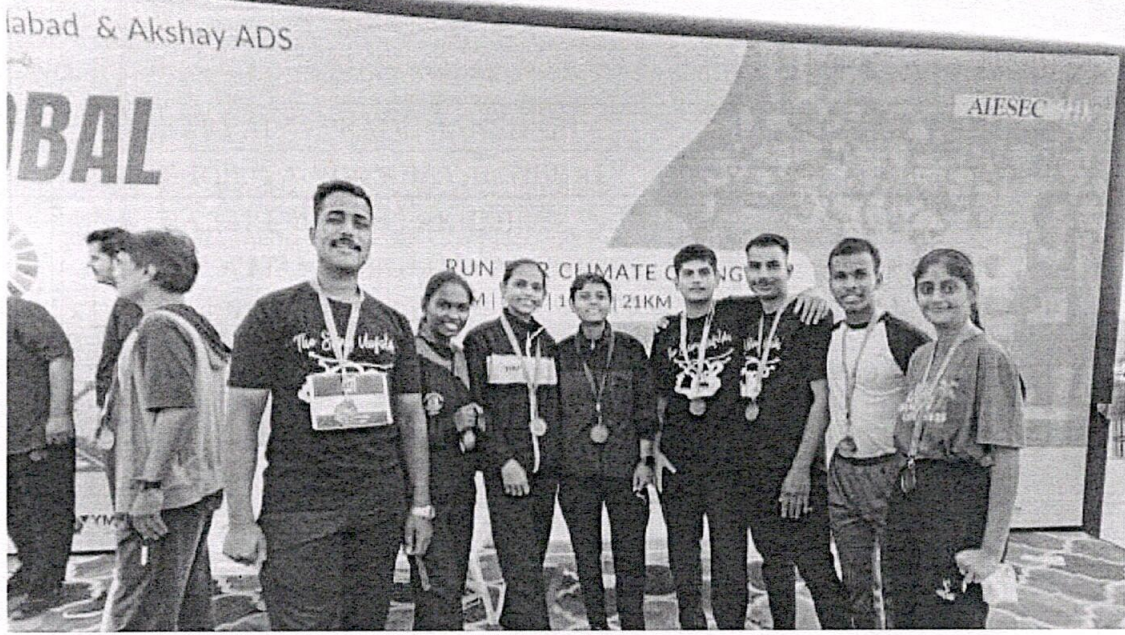

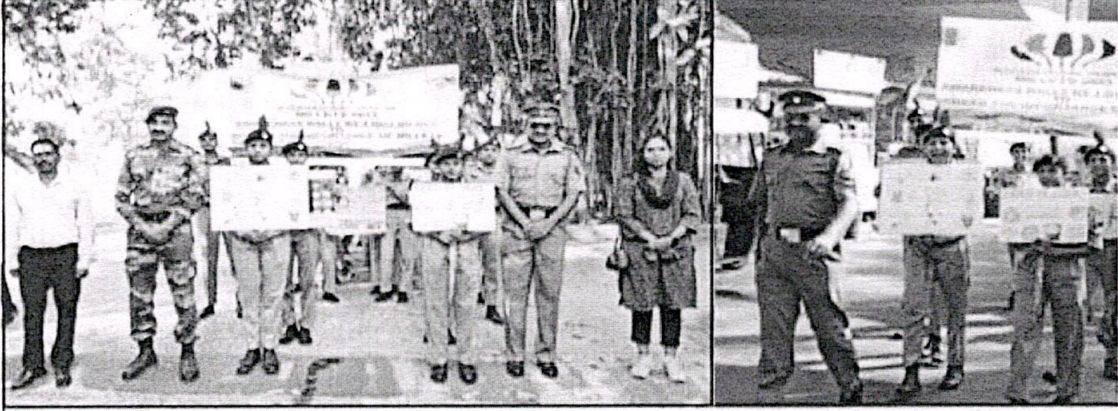

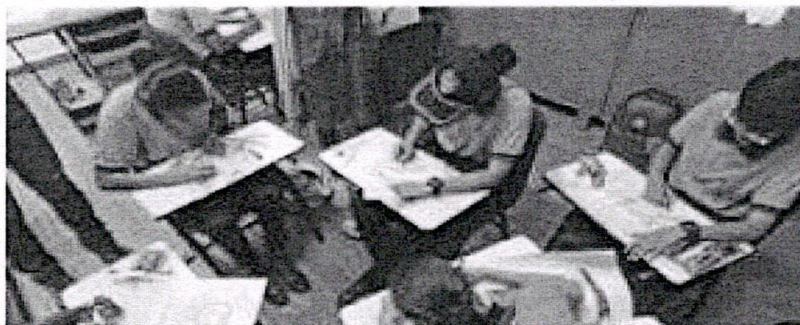

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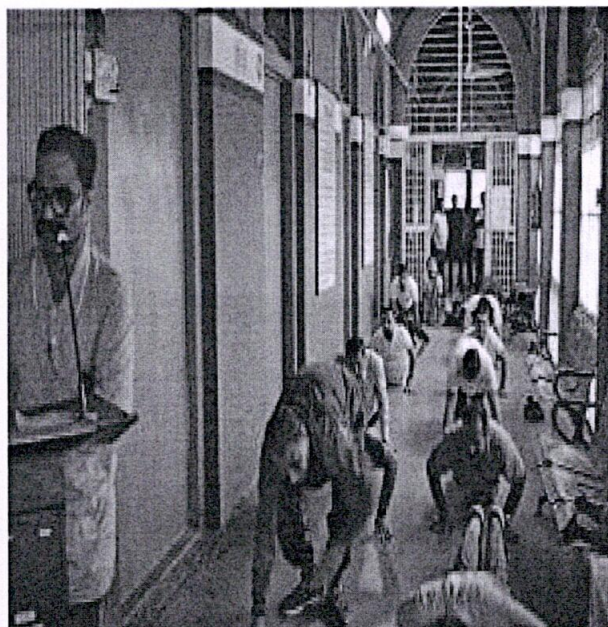
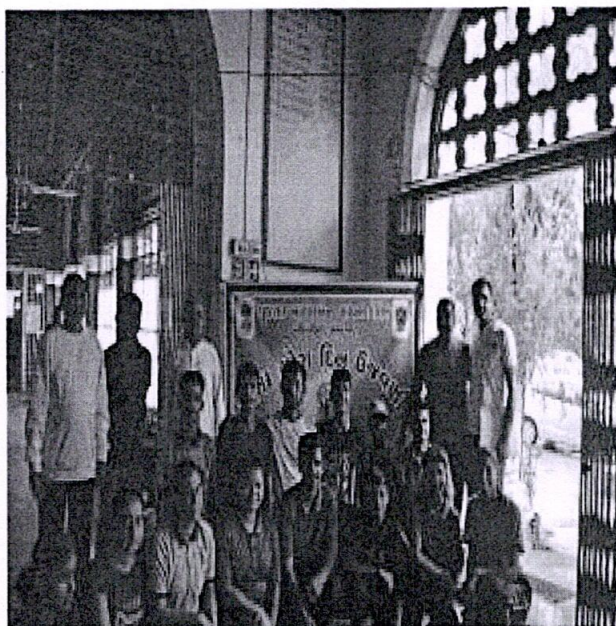
The World Yoga Day Programme Report

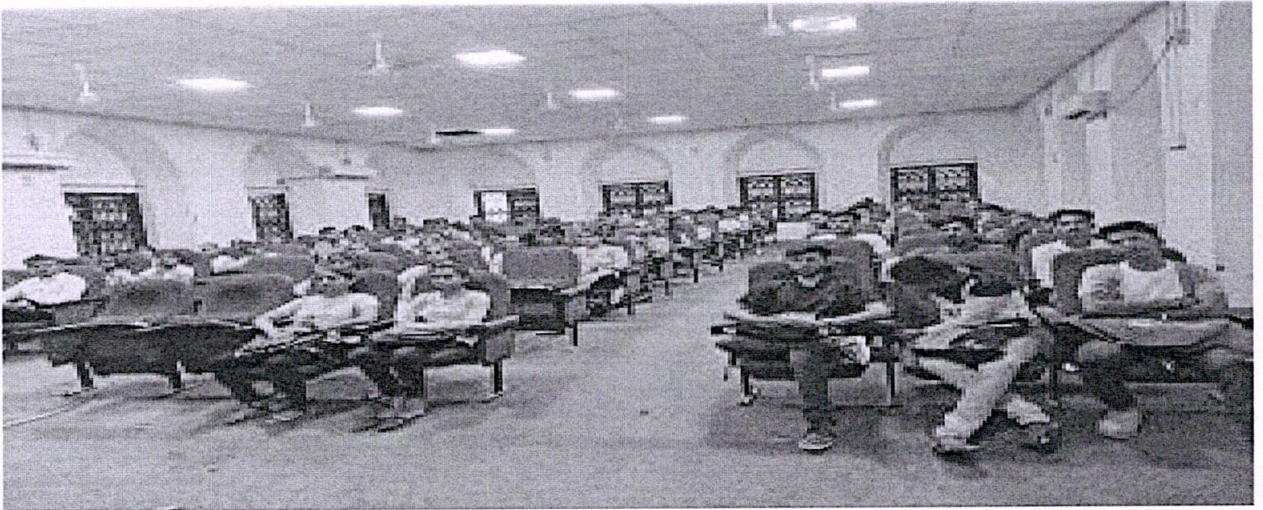
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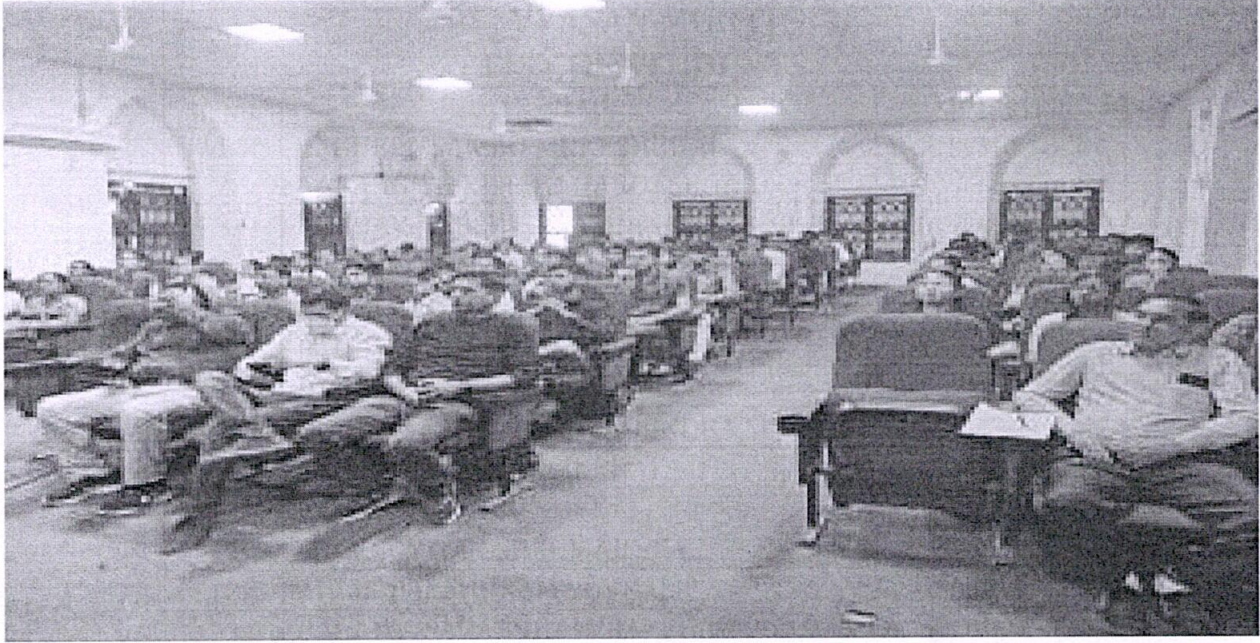
De - Addiction Program Report

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Cleanliness Campaign Report

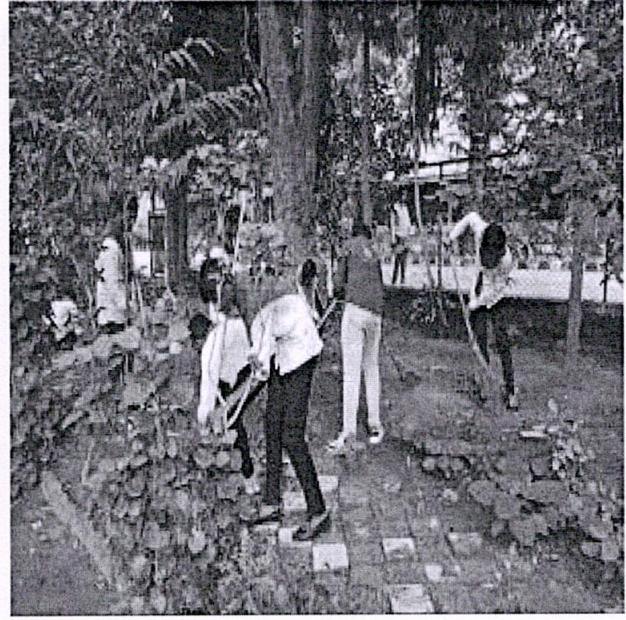
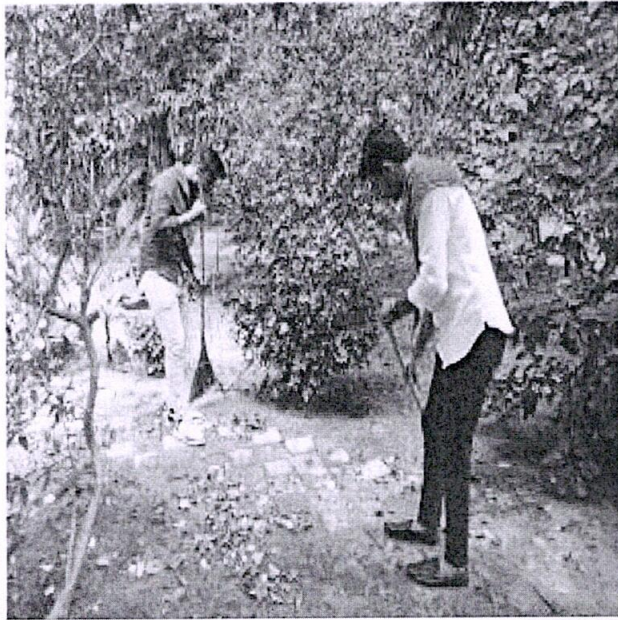

Date: 23/2/2022

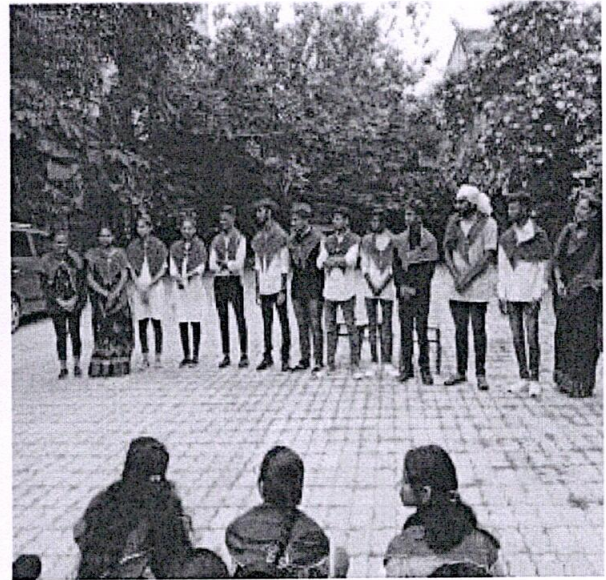

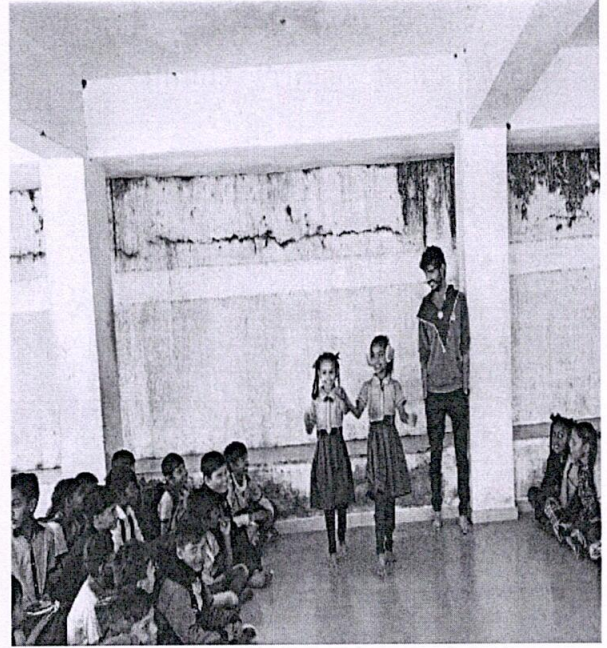

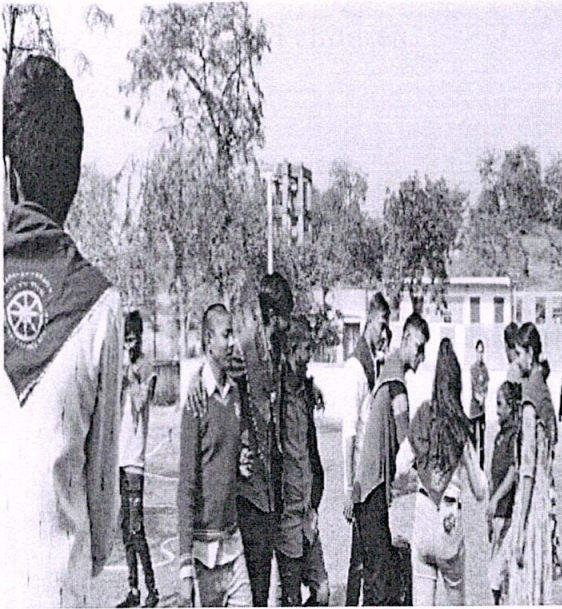

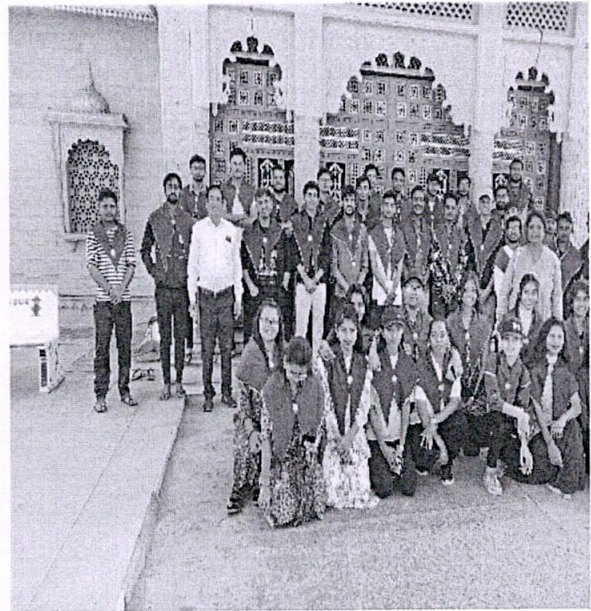

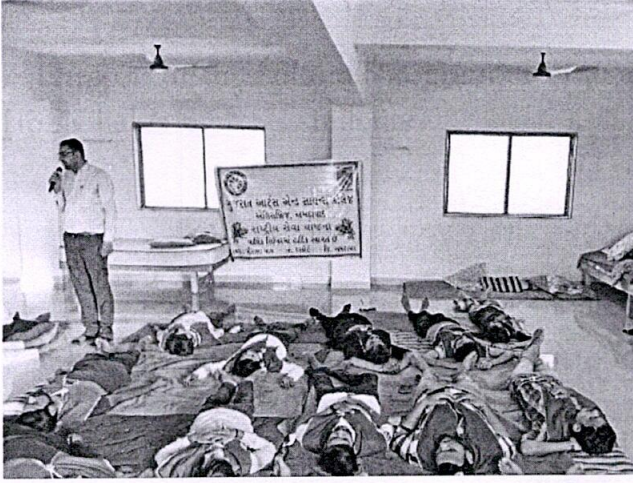
