• Coverage of Syllabus Material:

 Action: Implemented time management strategies to ensure comprehensive coverage of syllabus content. Adjusted course schedules to accommodate all topics. Outcome: Ensured thorough coverage of syllabus material, leading to enhanced student satisfaction.

• Teacher Preparation:

- Action: Encouraged faculty to attend professional development workshops and conferences. Promoted peer reviews and sharing of best practices among teachers.
- Outcome: Increased teacher preparedness and up-to-date knowledge, contributing to improved teaching quality.

• Teacher Communication:
