



#### 1. BASIC MOUNTAINEERING CAMP - FOREST EXPEDITION CAMP:





the team's performance. Therefore, the ANO closely monitored and interacted with TSC Cadets in CATC-V from July 18th to July 27th, 2018.



**CATC-V** - Shooting competition






# 2. TRAFFIC AWARENESS PROGRAMME:



# 1. INTER GROUP COMPETITION - THAL SAINIK CAMP (IGC-TSC):




# 2. EBSB CAMP:



of the occasion. This program exemplified the commitment of Gujarat Arts and Science College and the NCC to promoting cleanliness and hygiene for a better tomorrow.









# 2. COMBINED ANNUAL TRAINING CAMP-XIV (CATC-XIV):





#### Impact and Achievements:



#### Outcomes:


- A total of 500 saplings were planted across the college grounds.


Support and Encouragement:

#### 4. Interactive Sessions:







#### Activities:


- 1. Community Engagement and Outreach:


